By-law # 7991-23

Repeal of Heritage Designation

Being a By-law to repeal By-law # 1998-86, being a by-law to Designate the Structure Municipally known as 7143 Ashburn Road as being of Historic and Architectural Value and Interest.

Whereas Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18, as amended (the "Ontario Heritage Act") provides that an owner of a Property Designated under this Part may apply to the Council of the Municipality in which the property is situated to repeal the by-law or part thereof designating the property;

Whereas, in accordance with Section 32(5) of the Ontario Heritage Act, Council has consulted with its Municipal Heritage Committee on June 9, 2020, before repealing a by-law or part thereof designating the property;

Whereas, in accordance with Section 32(3) of the Ontario Heritage Act, Council has caused Notice of the Intention to repeal the by-law to be published on March 2, 2023, in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality; and,

Whereas, in accordance with Section 32(5) of the Ontario Heritage Act, no Notice of Objection to the proposed repeal of By-law # 1998-86 has been served on the Clerk of the Town of Whitby;

Now therefore, in accordance with Section 32(5)2 of the Ontario Heritage Act, the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitby hereby enacts as follows:

1. Repeal of Existing By-law

- 1.1. That By-law # 1998-86 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
