Prohibited & Regulated Animals By-law Exemption Request for Nova's Ark – 7505

Cedarbrook Trail

Background

Over the weekend, staff had discussions with Nova's Ark regarding their Order to Comply to re-home all prohibited animals issued on July 13, 2023 (the "**Order**"), today's Committee of the Whole meeting, and Report LS 12-23. The Order is set to expire on January 12, 2024.

Nova's Ark have indicated that they would be willing to comply with the Order and the Prohibited and Regulated Animals By-law No. 7392-18 (the "**PRA By-law**") subject to some additional time to comply.

Discussion

Nova's Ark, as well as Mary-Ann and Geoff Nova in their capacity as the landowners of 7505 Cedarbrook Trail, have provided the attached letter to Council outlining their withdrawal of their request for an exemption to the PRA By-law, as well their willingness to comply with the PRA By-law (see Attachment 1 to this Memorandum, Correspondence # 2024-22). They have also indicated to staff that they intend to comply with the Town's PRA By-law through re-homing prohibited animals.

Conclusion

Enforcement Staff's aim continues to be compliance with the PRA By-law.

Staff will be working with Nova's Ark and Mary-Ann and Geoff Nova to achieve compliance with the PRA By-law. Should Council accept the correspondence and withdrawal of the request for an exemption of the PRA By-law from Nova's Ark and Mary-Ann and Geoff Nova, staff suggest that the following recommendations be considered:

- That Council receive and accept Correspondence #2024-22 from Nova's Ark withdrawing its request for an exemption to the Prohibited and Regulated Animals By-law; and,
- 2. That Council refers Correspondence #2024-22 and Report LS 12-23 to Staff to manage in accordance with the July 13, 2023 Order to Comply.
