Project Highlights from 2023

- Started construction on a new community centre (Whitby Sports Complex). This facility has been designed to exceed Ontario Building Code accessibility requirements.
- Re-established the Accessibility Staff Working Group to rejuvenate the commitment to accessibility throughout the corporation.
- Continue to enhance the partnerships with the Accessibility Advisory Committee, the 55+ Recreation Committee of Council and the Diversity and Inclusion Advisory Committee to implement inclusivity initiatives within Whitby.
- Began the implementation of the Council adopted Accessible Signage and Wayfinding Standard.



- Continued to develop and retrofit parks and playgrounds to increase inclusive play opportunities for children of all ages and abilities and their caregivers.

- Migration of web-based forms from PDF format to on-line format to increase usability of forms for all customers.
- Updated many of the Town's webpages, to improve access to information for all customers, including pages for the 55+ centre.
